## Autumn 1:

### Animal Patterns and Textures

Striped tigers, Spotted leopards, Scaly snakes, Shaggy highland cows, Spiky hedgehogs, Iridescent beetles, Speckled fawns, Furry arctic hares, Slimy frogs, Feathered peacocks, Armoured armadillos, Smooth dolphins, Woolly sheep

## Spring 1:

### Nocturnal and Mysterious Creatures

Barn owls, Bats, Red foxes, Fireflies, Ocelots, Kiwis, Wolves, Aye-ayes, Slow lorises, Tarantulas, Moths, Lynx, Hedgehogs

## Summer 1:

### Baby Animals and Family Groups

Lion cubs, Ducklings, Baby penguins, Elephant calves, Lambs, Piglets, Gorilla babies, Joeys (baby kangaroos), Baby sloths, Cygnets (baby swans), Otter families, Seal pups, Chicks and hens

## Autumn 2:

### Animal Movements and Poses

Leaping gazelles, Swimming sea lions, Pouncing snow leopards, Gliding flying squirrels, Soaring eagles, Trotting zebras, Burrowing moles, Hopping kangaroos, Slithering pythons, Crawling turtles, Running cheetahs, Swinging gibbons, Diving kingfishers

## Spring 2:

### Animals and Their Homes

Beavers in lodges, Penguins on ice, Kangaroos in the outback, Bees in hives, Bats in caves, Hermit crabs in shells, Bears in dens, Birds in nests, Wolves in forests, Crabs on coral reefs, Mice in meadows, Horses on open plains, Red pandas in bamboo forests

## Summer 2:

### Animals of the World

Watercolour whales, Playful octopus, Woodland foxes, Tropical toucans, Gentle elephants, Graceful butterflies, Friendly otters, Colourful chameleons, Fluffy rabbits, Ancient turtles, Wise owls, Curious meerkats, Endangered pandas
