

# Creating Your Own Custom Skin

*(Works on both Java and Bedrock editions.)*

## What you'll need:

- An internet connection.
- A skin editor or template (like [minecraftskins.com](https://minecraftskins.com), [pmskin3d](https://pmskin3d.com) or [skindex](https://skindex.com)).

## Steps:

- 1. Find or create a skin:**
  - Use a skin editor online to design your own.
  - Or download a ready-made skin and edit it.
- 2. Save the skin:**
  - Download it as a png file.
- 3. Upload to Minecraft (Java):**
  - Go to [minecraft.net/profile](https://minecraft.net/profile).
  - Sign in with your Microsoft account.
  - Click **Change Skin**.
  - Upload your png file.
- 4. Upload to Minecraft (Bedrock – Windows and Mobile):**
  - Open Minecraft.
  - From the main menu, click the **hanger icon** (Character Customisation).
  - Select **Owned** → **Import** → **Choose New Skin**.
  - Upload the png file.
  - Choose slim or classic model.
- 5. Enjoy your new look!**
  - Load into the game and see your new skin in action.

On consoles you can only use skins available in the **Marketplace** or free skins already built into the game.
